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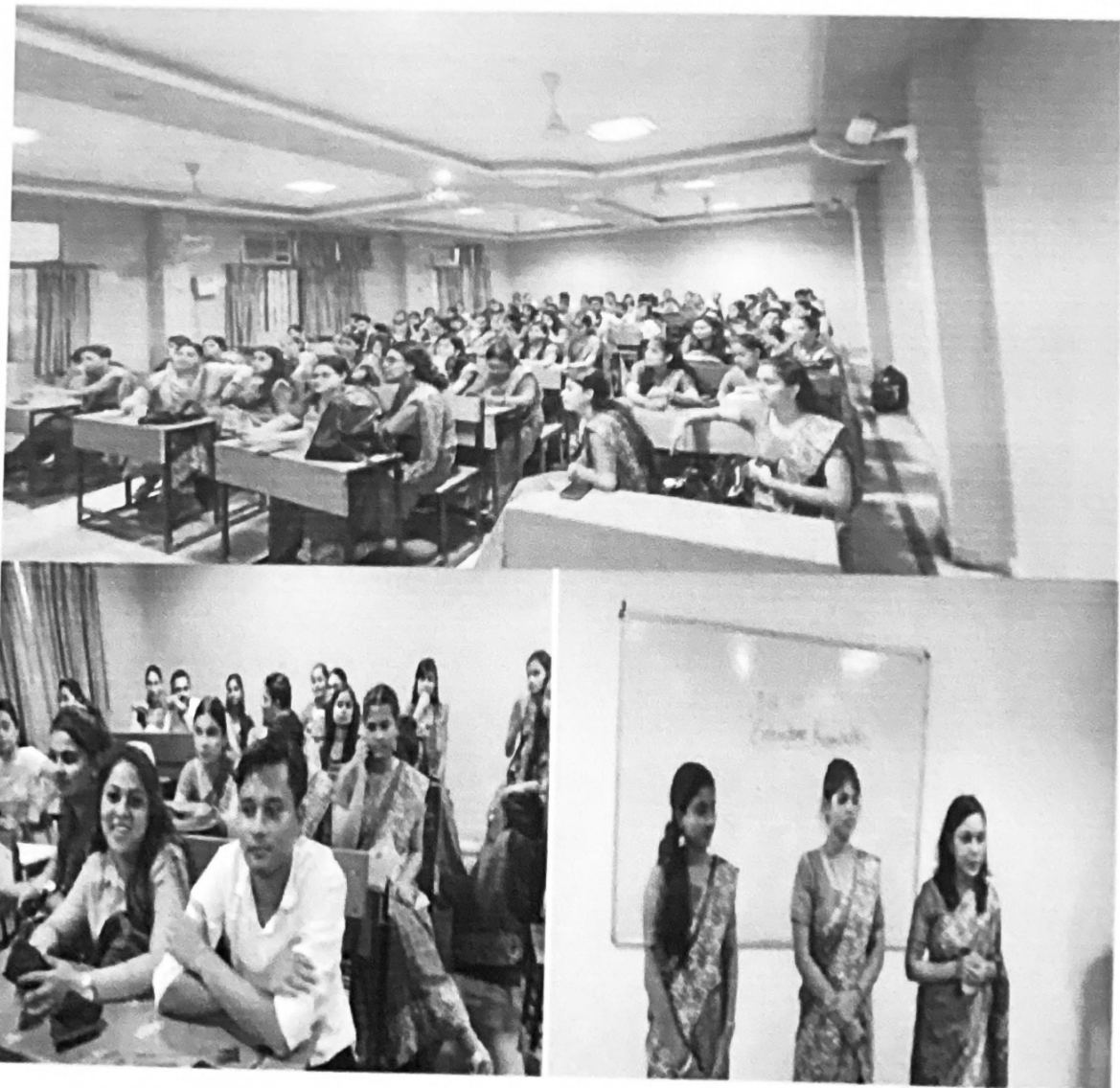
Celebration of Iconic Figures

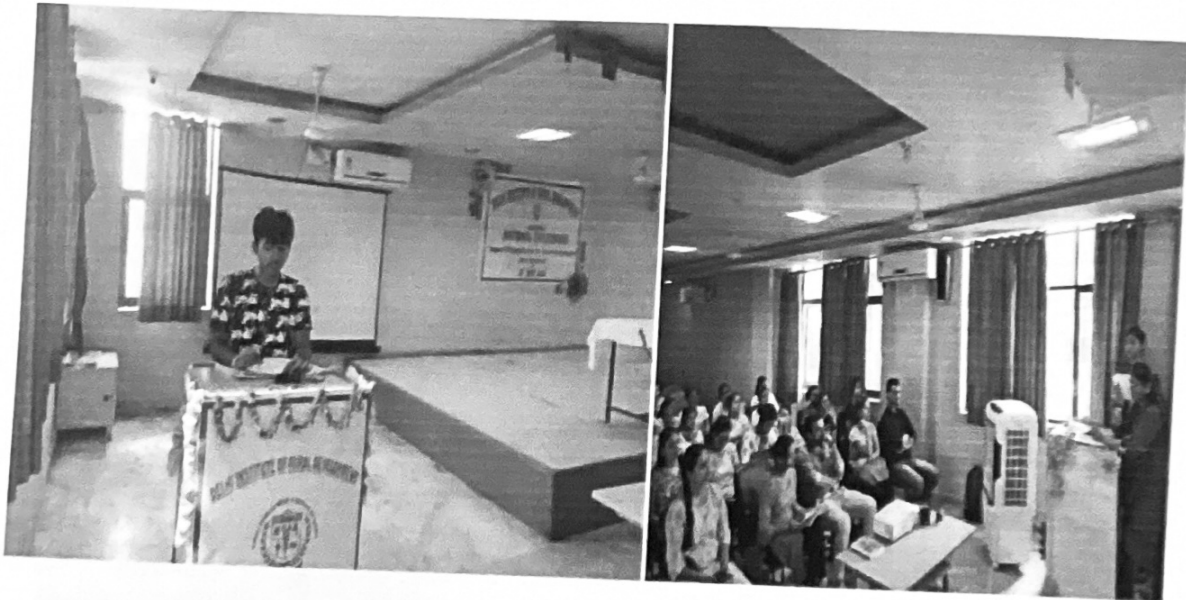


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Poetry Recitation Competition

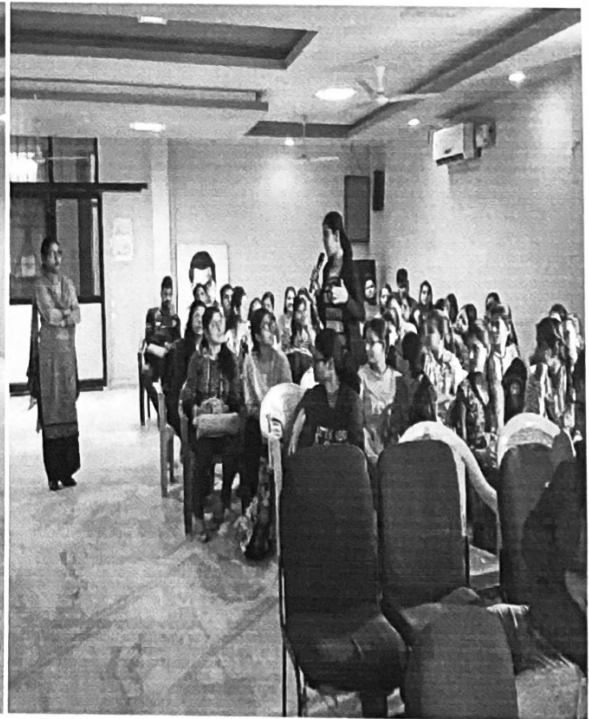


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Debate on Women Empowerment

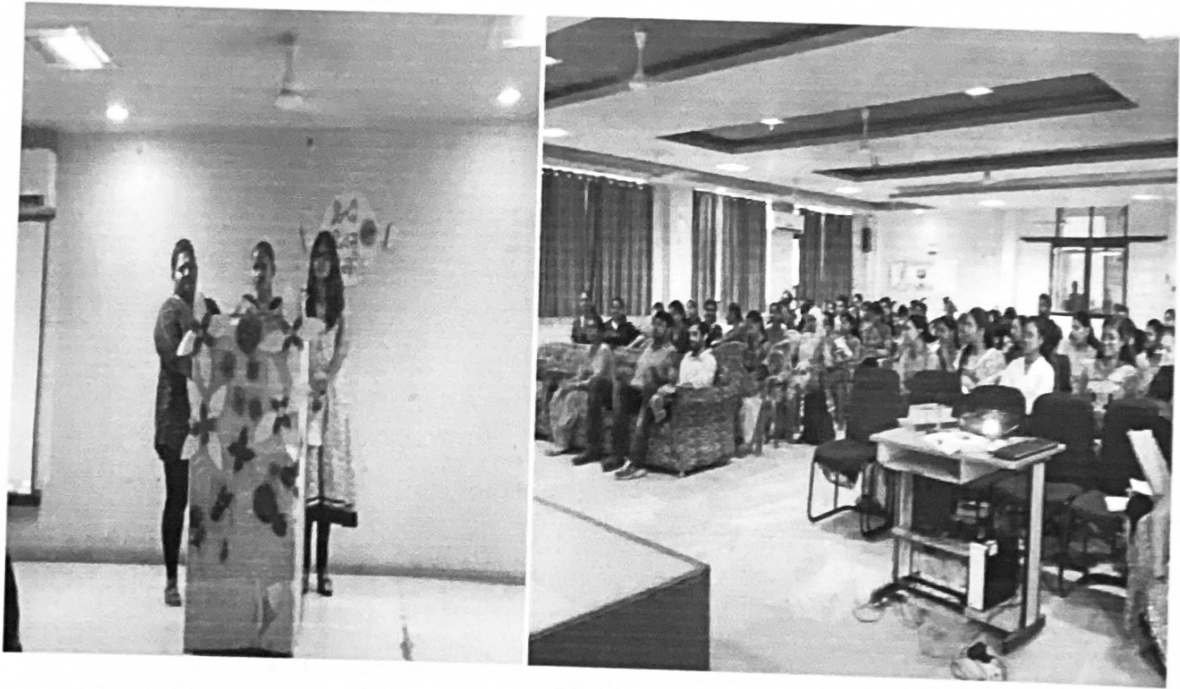


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Hindi Diwas Celebration

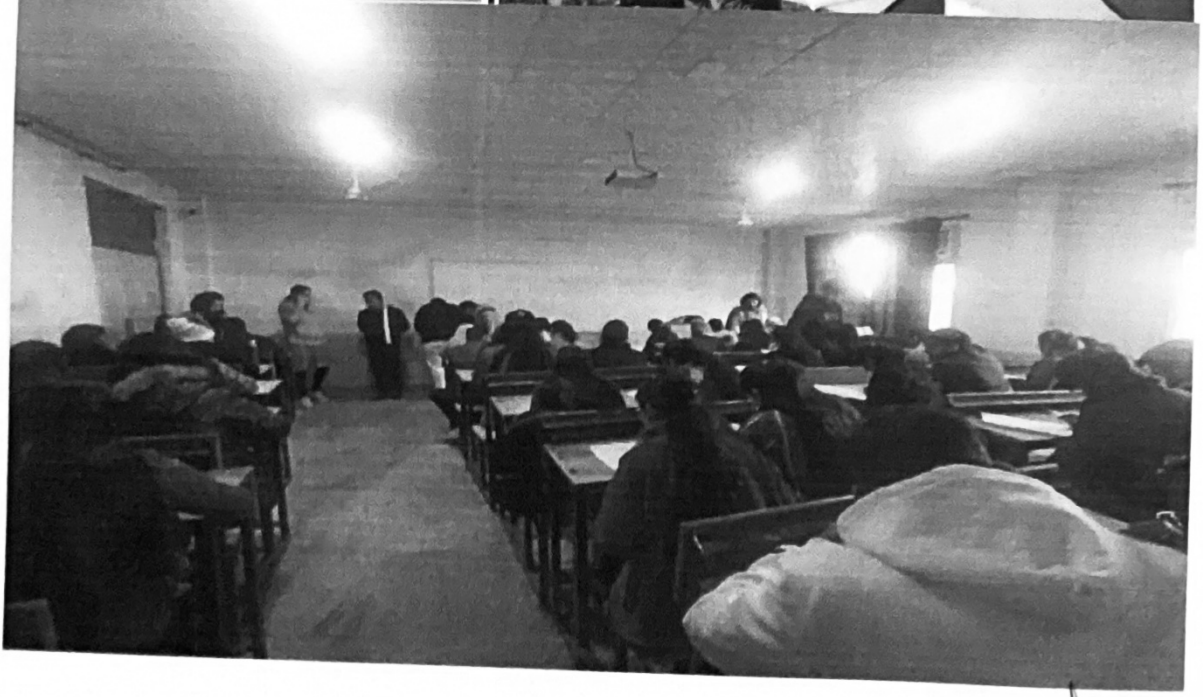

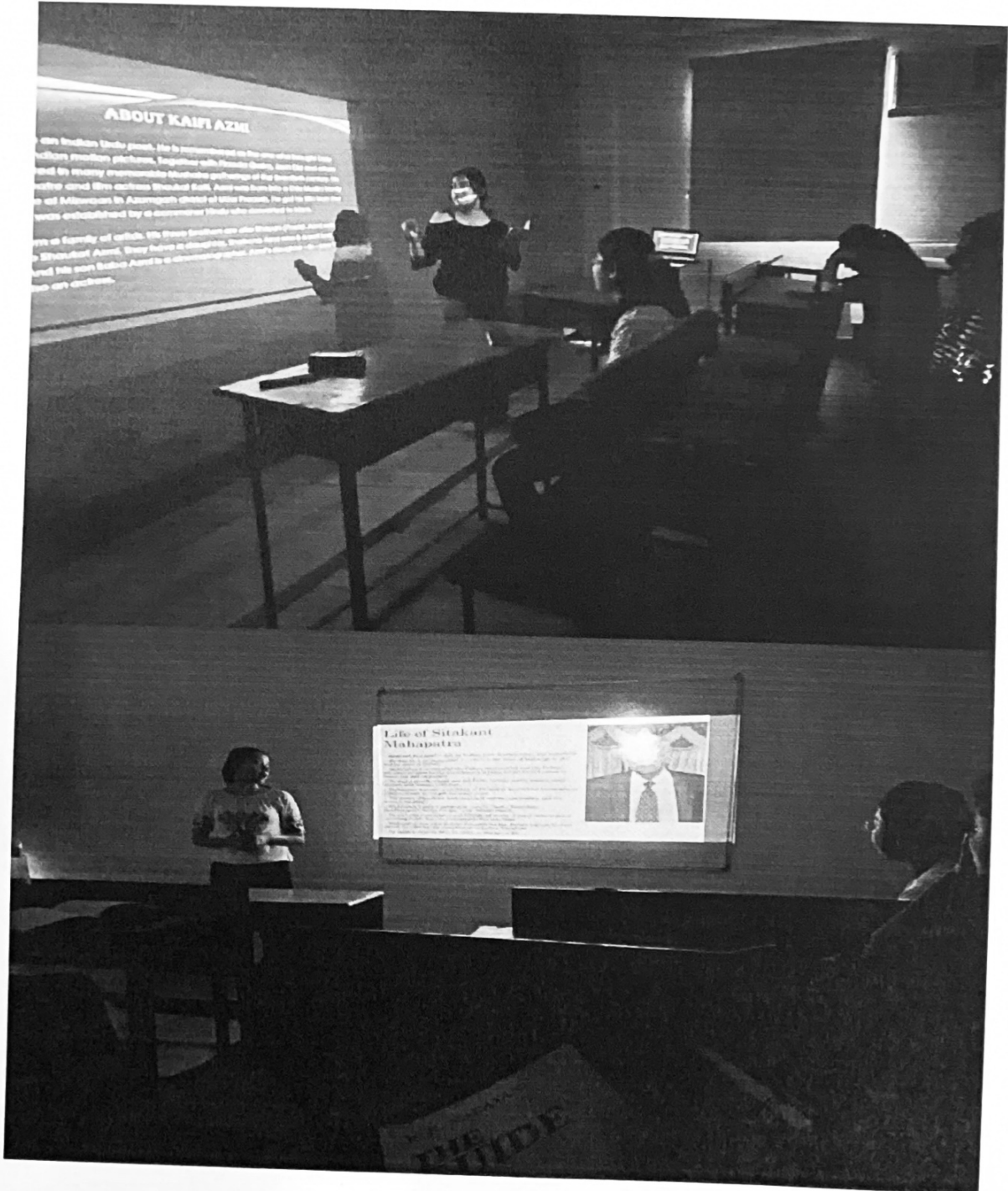
