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## Street Play

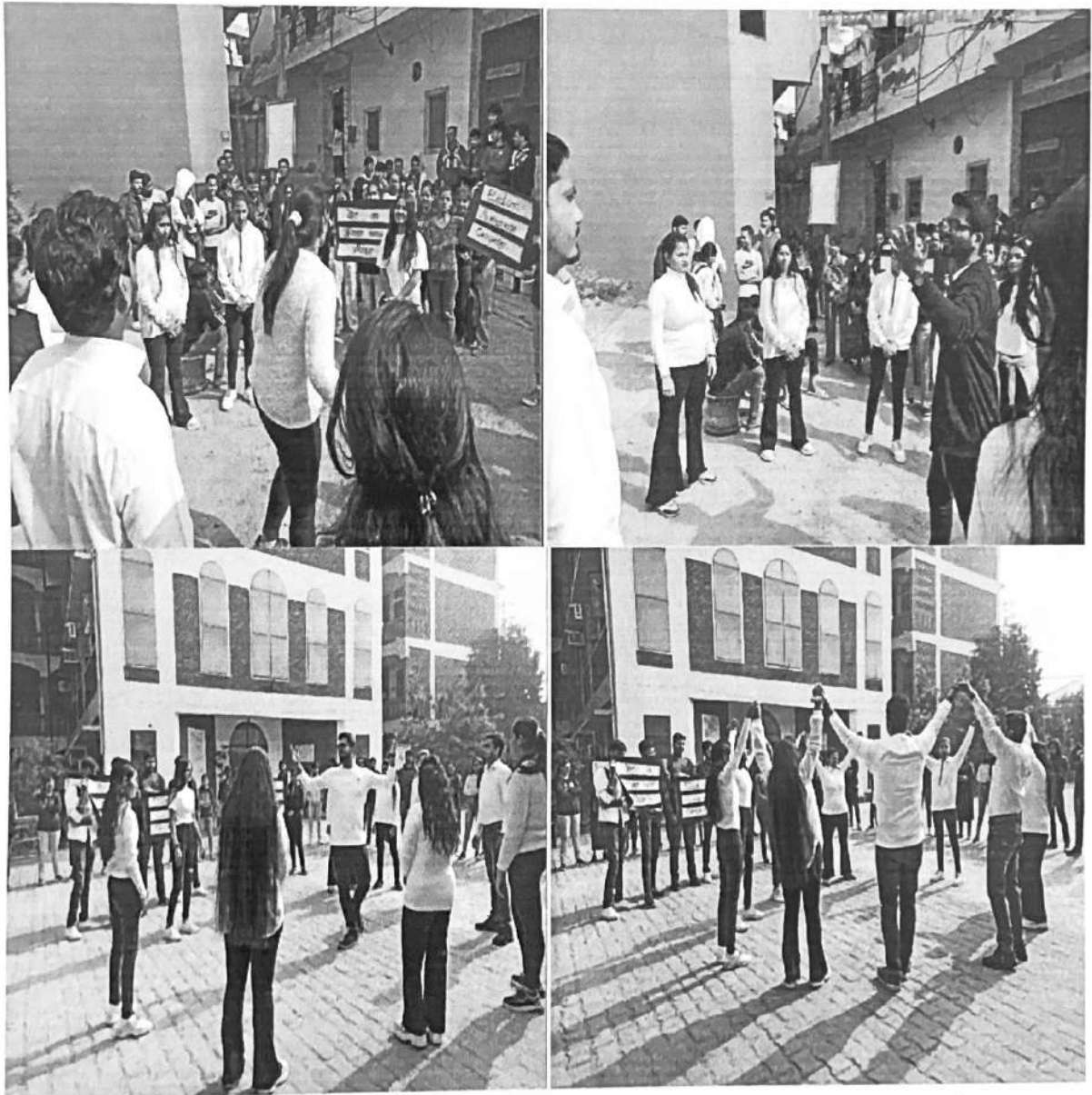

## Nukkad Natak and Awareness Rally on Earth Day

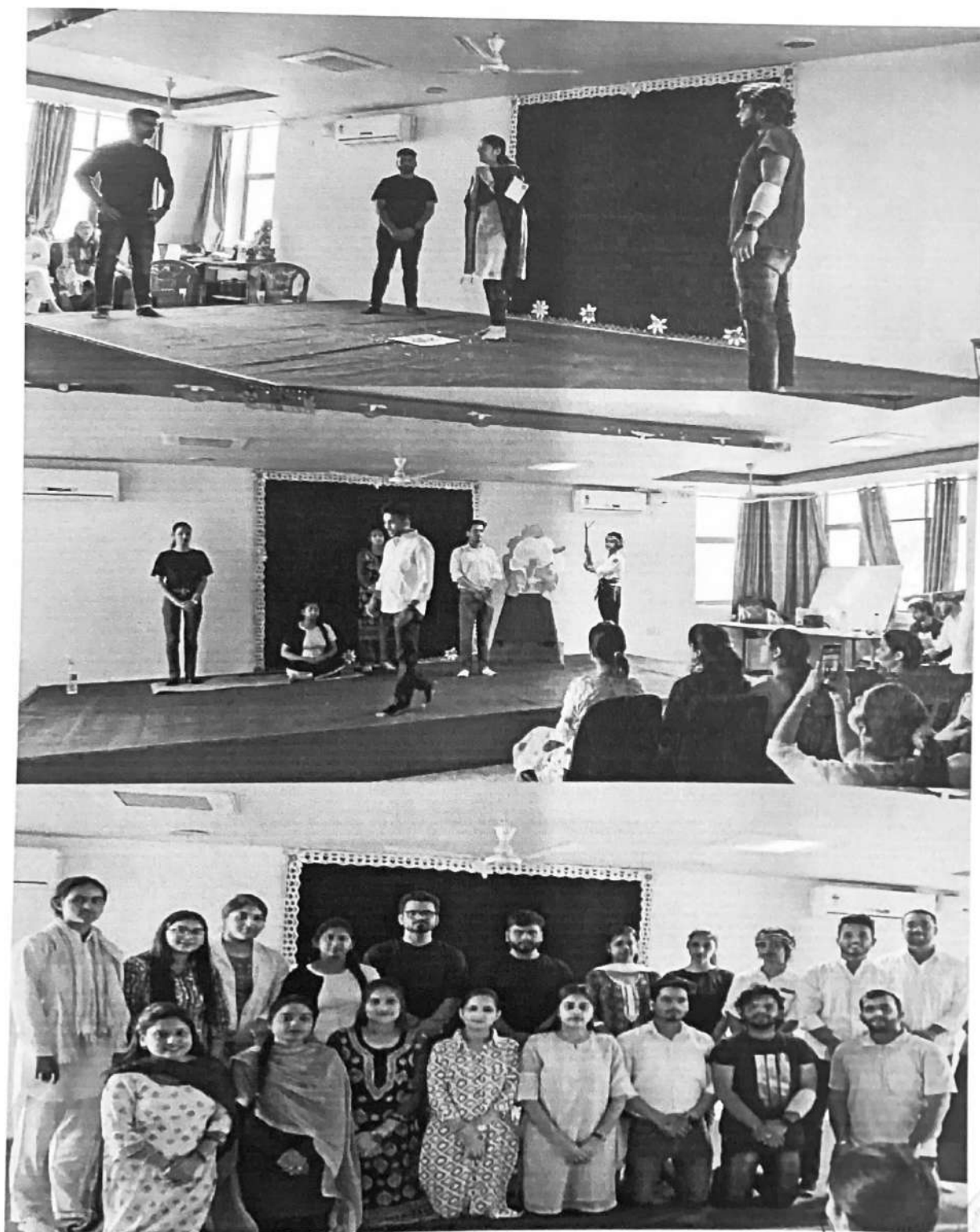

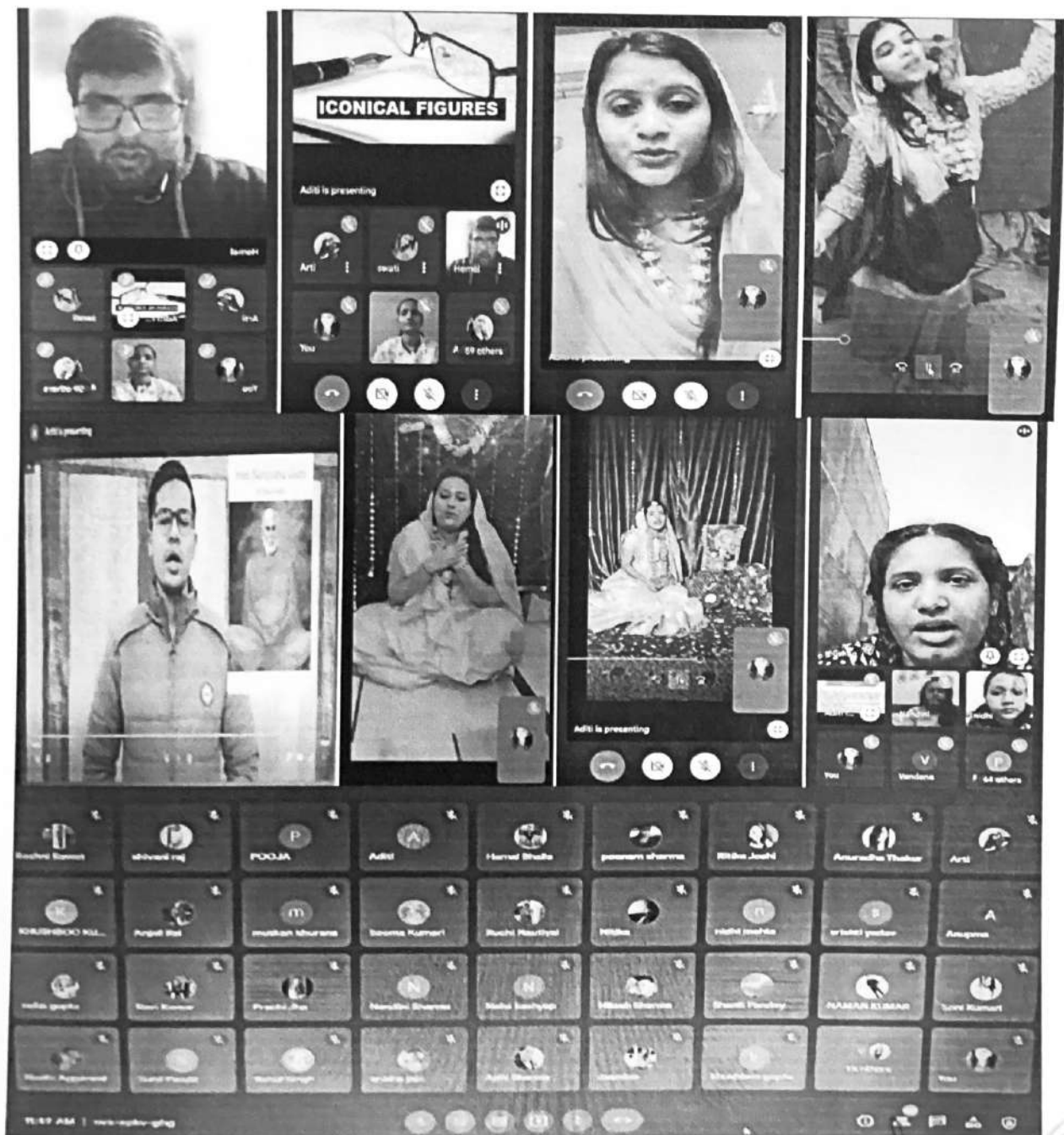


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## Celebration of Iconic Figures

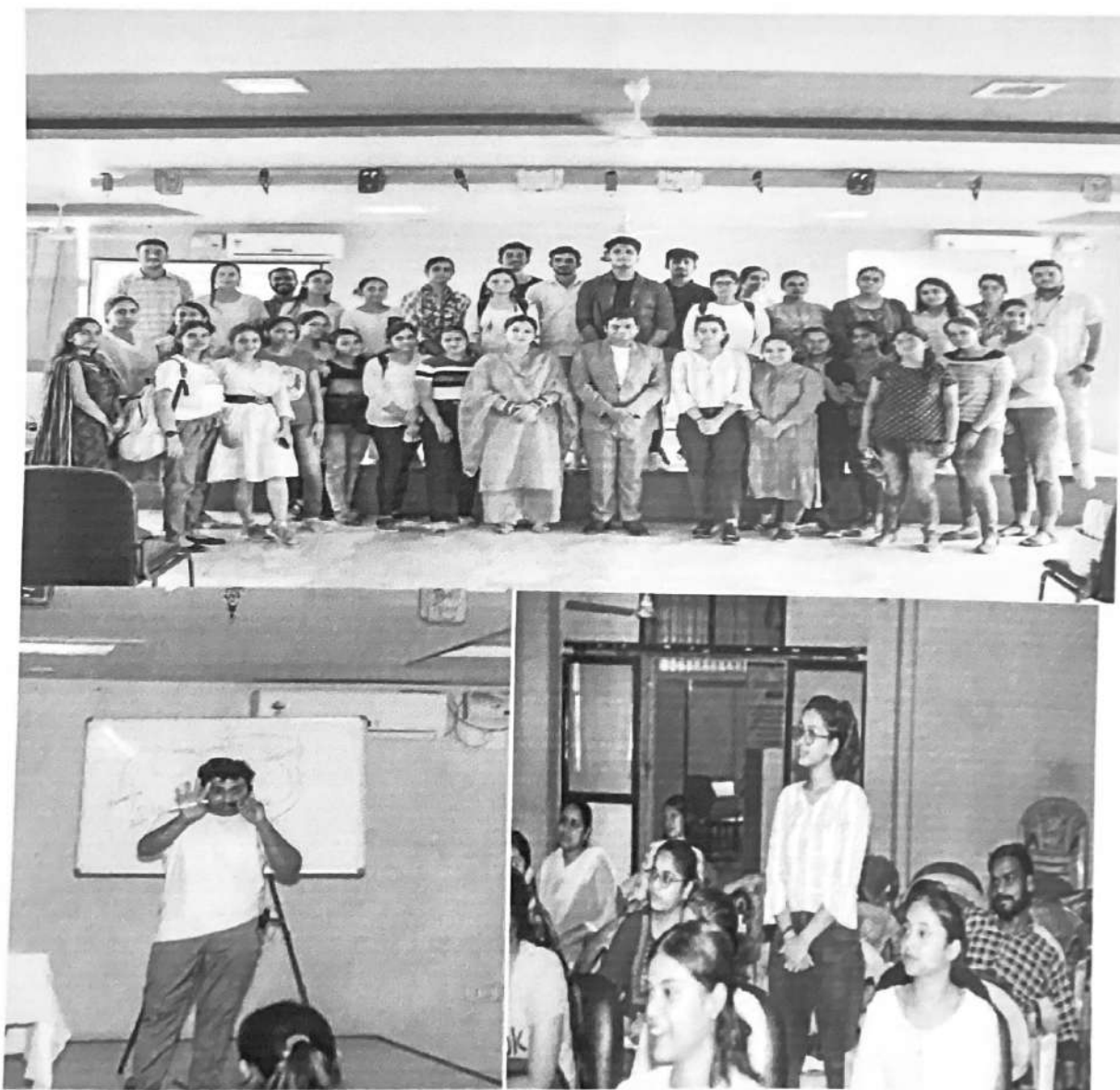


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### Workshop on Communication & Public Speaking

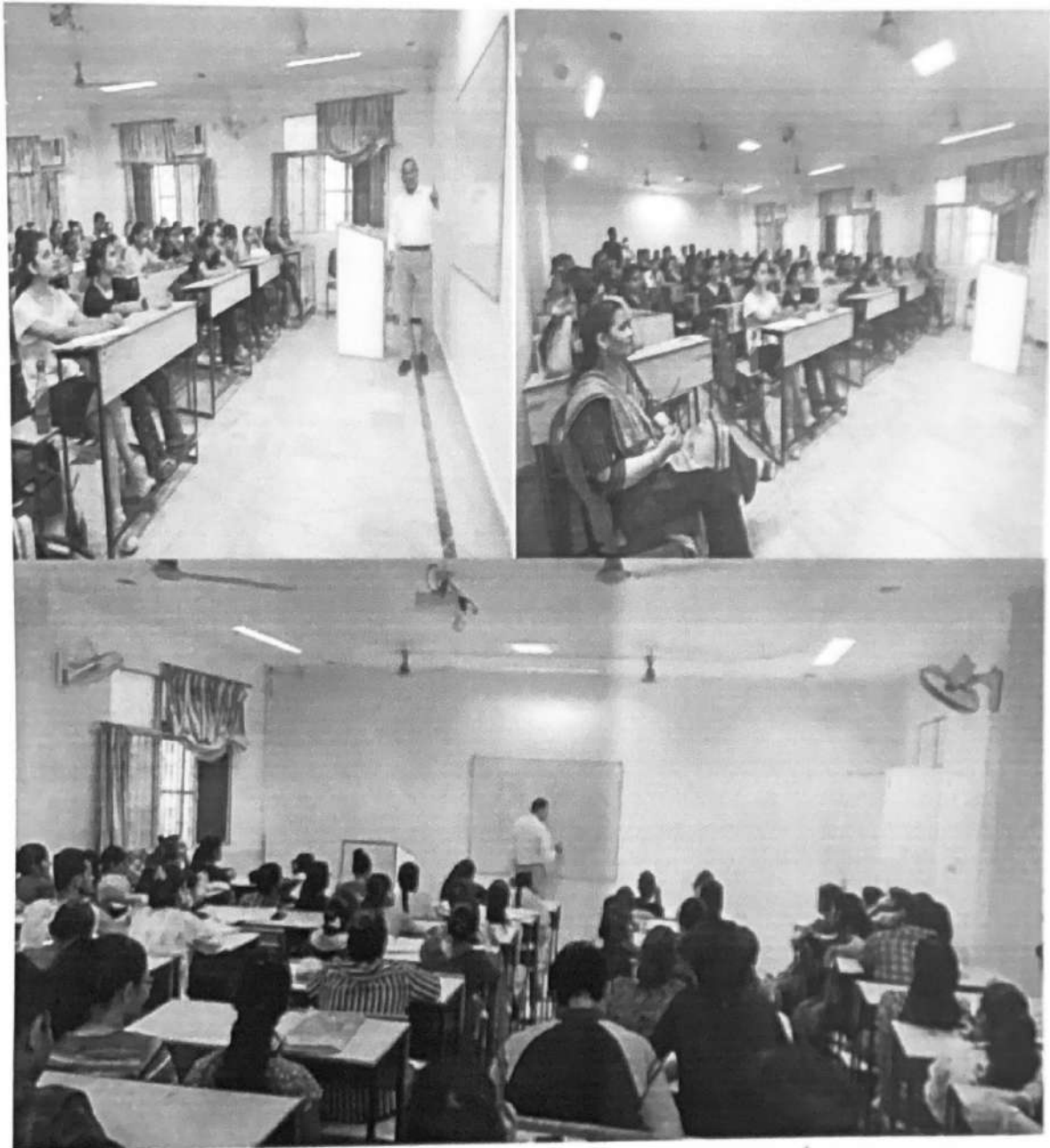

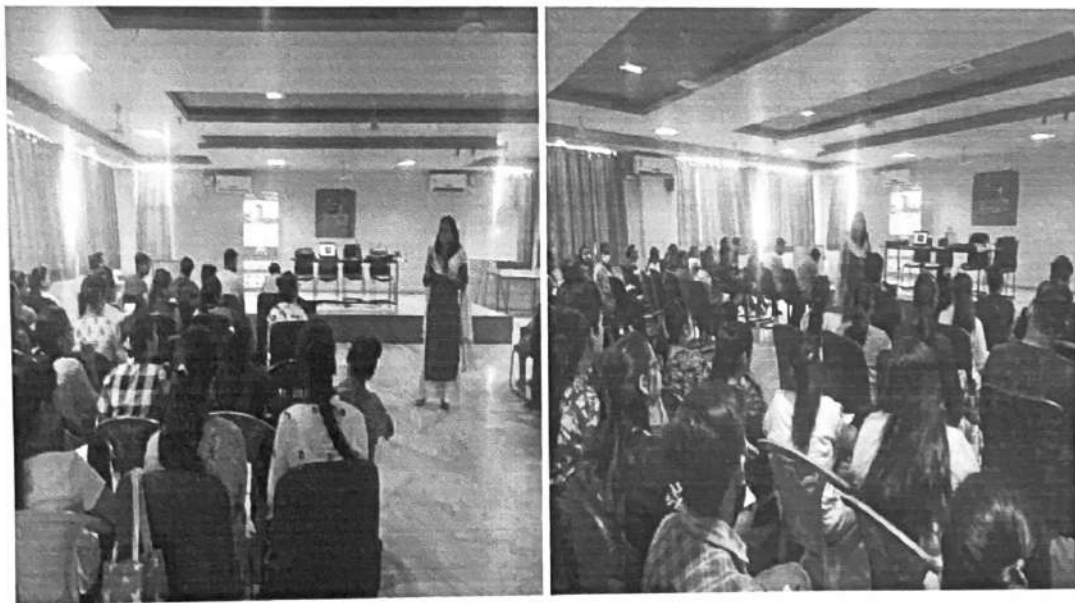

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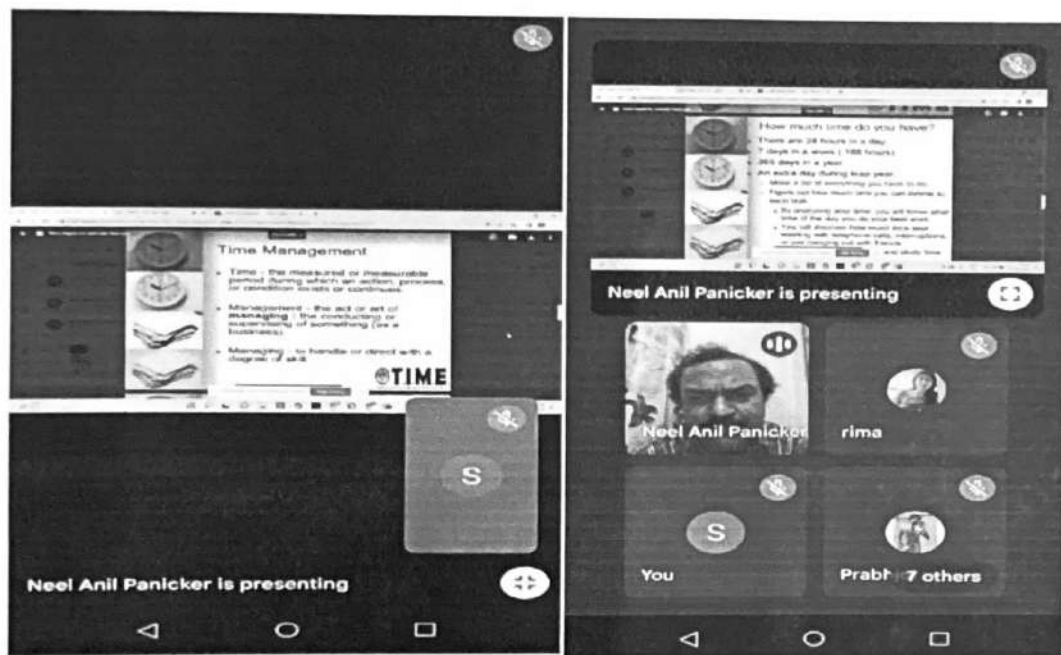
**Title:** Webinar on Time Management –New Situation New Challenges

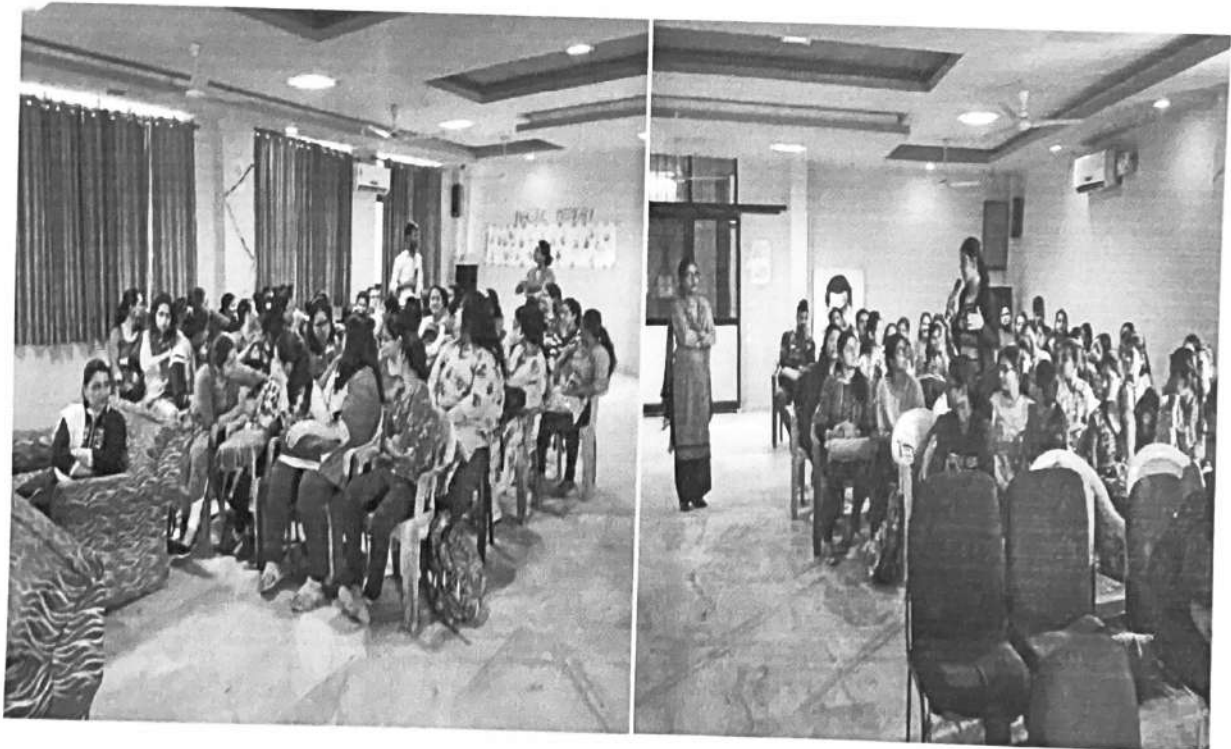


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### Debate on Women Empowerment

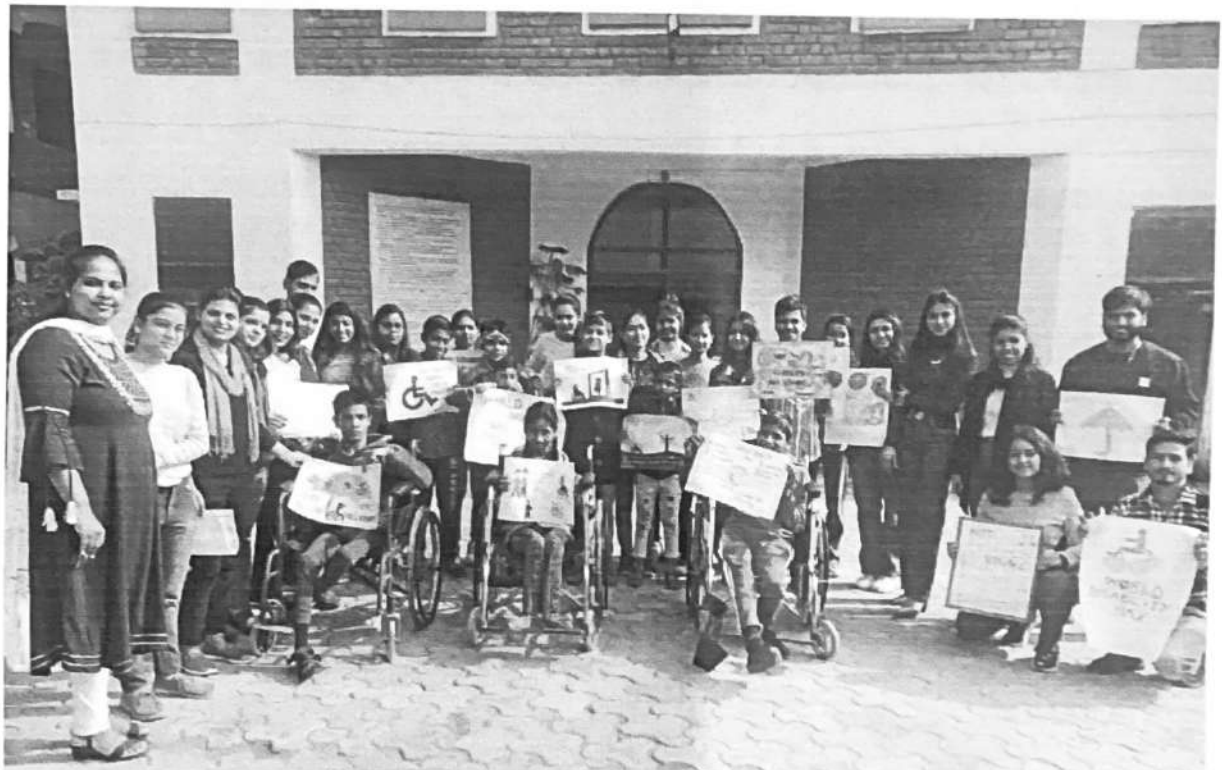


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### Poster Making Competition on Disability Day

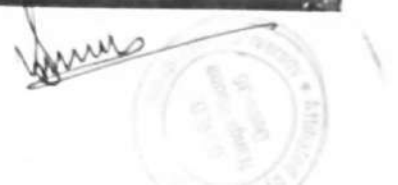


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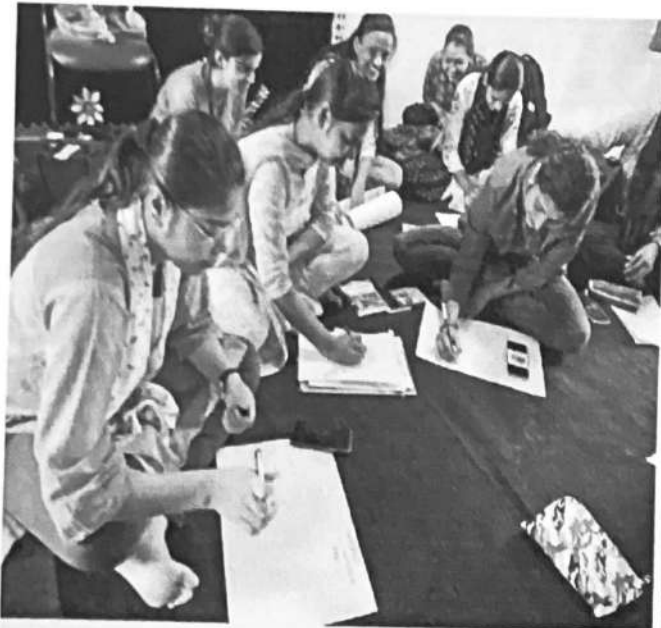
## Rangoli Making Competition on Diwali

### Surajkund International Fair February 2022

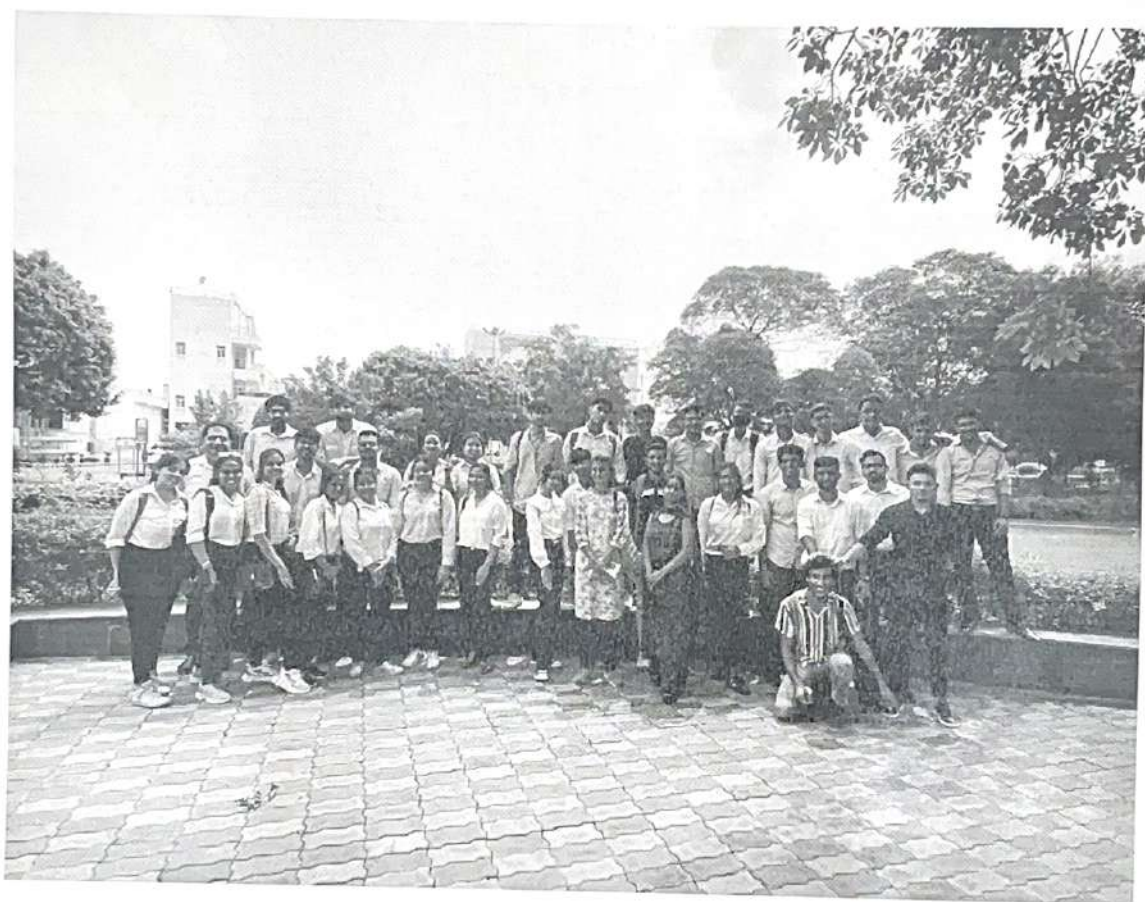

### Industrial Visit to Bisleri

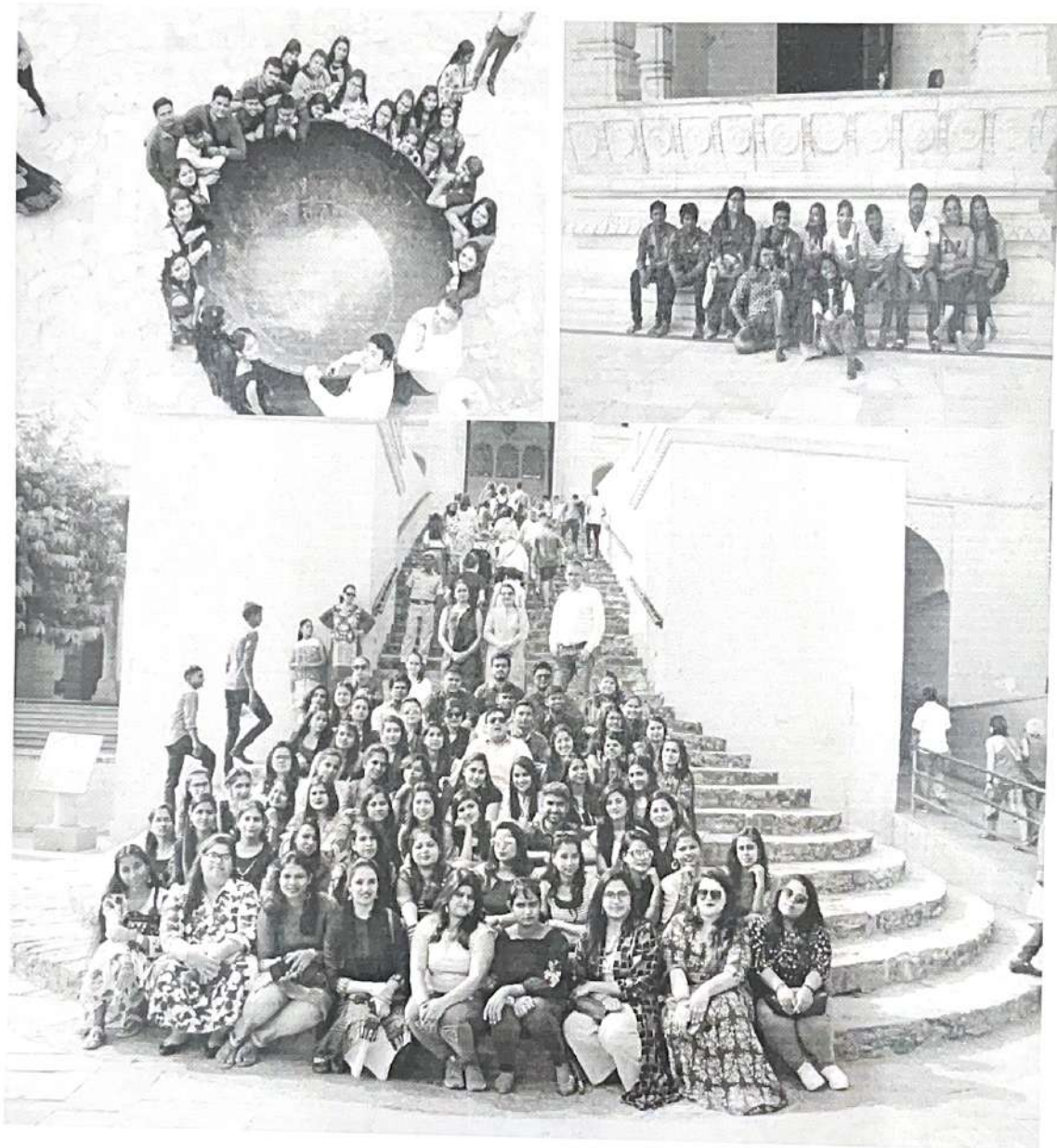

### Visit to Amrit Udyan

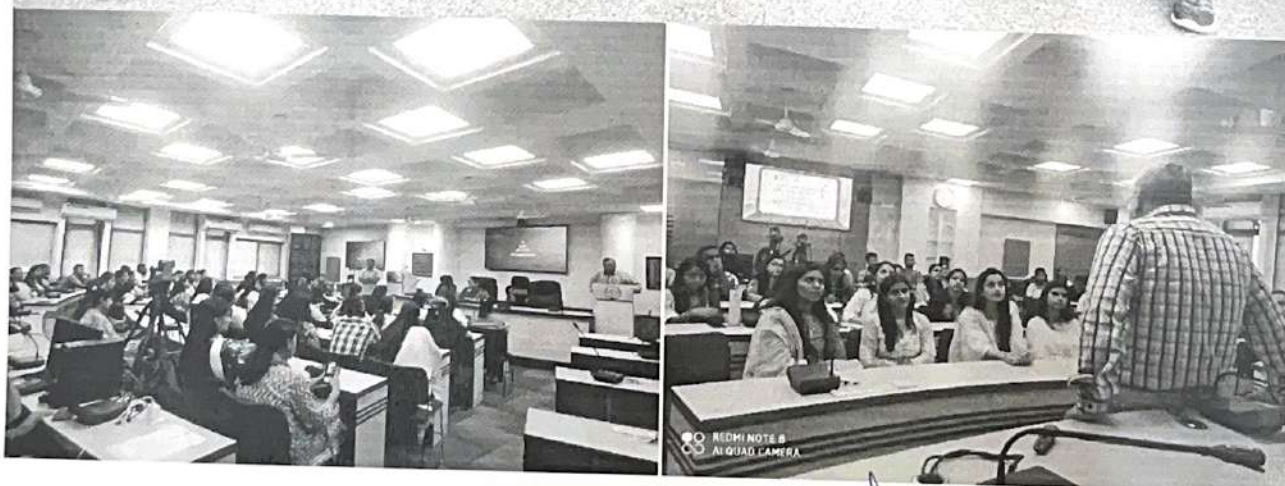
