
Mock Interview


Nukkad Natak on Election Awareness


Nukkad Natak and Awareness Rally on Earth Day


Discussion on Gandhian Thought




Debate on Women Empowerment


EXTEMPORE

Workshop on Art & Drama in Education




He induces student rather than calling workshop Ms Shw generate ideas and Students give unique. The pith of the workshop encourages them to feedback and share


Workshop on Mental Wellness, Jan 2024


Slogan & Poster Making Competition 2023






Best Out of Waste Competition




Quiz Competition

Independence Day Celebration



Fresher's Party - Qalb 2023



Lohri Celebration 2024




Teacher's Day Celebrations




Yoga Activity

International Yoga Day 2024






Hindi Diwas Celebration





Rally on Election Awareness Campaign



Health Mela IPU 2023




Sports Activity

Visit to NCERT






Visit to New Delhi World Book Fair 2024



Visit to Amrit Udyan



VISIT TO DILLI HAAT



Visit to the National Gallery of Modern Art





